



DECLARATION OF ORGANIC FRENCH AND AMERICAN OAK

There is not organic certification for French and American white oak used for winemaking. Because oak trees grow naturally and they are not cultivated, they could be considered organically grown due to the absence of pesticides and fertilizer applications. When the logs are processed, no chemicals are added or used and air-drying occurs naturally in the mill's seasoning yards.

At Heinrich Alternatives all the oak we use comes from our own mills, so we can be sure of the quality and origin of our supplies.
